BRIEF HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION

Holy Cross Home Science College, Thoothukudi, established in 1975, is administered by the Society of the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod, Madurai Province. The college is affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. It was Re accredited with 'B' grade by NAAC.

In order to create an aesthetic sense among the women of Thoothukudi, the sisters dreamed of starting a technical institution. The campus which housed the Tamil Literature Society was purchased by the sisters in 1955 from the Tuticorin Diocesan Association represented by the Bishop of Tuticorin.

The pioneers of this institution were

Sr.Imelda Sr.Pia

Sr.Lawrencia Sr.Pauline.

Sr.Carmeline

In the same year (1955), the sisters started a technical school for needle work, dress-making and embroidery and also a nursery school. In November 1955, the first set of girls were sent for the Government Technical Examination. In 1966, the technical school was raised to the status of Home Science Academy with the introduction of two year diploma course in Home Science. Sr.Rita served as the Director and Sr. Audrey as Assistant.

The thrust of this academy was to train young girls for an ideal family life and to live as better citizens. They were taught Human Development, Textiles, Food and Nutrition, and Home Management. Besides young girls, married women also attended certificate courses in cookery and needle work. The course was approved by the Tamilnadu Government and the first batch of students appeared for the Government Examination in 1968. This course was in vogue until 1995.

Early in February 1973, the University of Madras had asked the Sisters to take up B.Sc. Degree course in Home Science. Then Holy Cross Home Science Academy was raised to the status of a college in 1975 with the introduction of B.Sc., degree course in Home Science. The college was first affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai. Sr. Elizabeth Rose was appointed as the first Principal of the college. Since 1990, the college is affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli.

A nursery school within the campus, provided facilities to learn the behavioural pattern of little ones and also the psychological, emotional and social changes that occur during their pre-school period. This formed a part of the practical work in Human Development studies in B.Sc. Food Science and Nutrition.

Dr. Sr.Phyllis served as the Principal of the college from 1978 to 2002. Thanks to the efforts taken by Sr.Phyllis, in 1994 the P.G Diploma course in Nutrition, Food Service Management and Dietetics (NFSMD) was started.

Dr. Sr.Mary Gilda was the Principal of the college from 2002-2010. To cater to the growing needs of the student community, she introduced M.Sc. in Dietetics and Food Management in 2003 and B.Com. with Computer Application. B.Sc. Fashion Designing and Apparel Making in 2006 and B.Sc. Computer Science in 2007. Besides, she added more infrastructure facilities to the college. B.A English Literature and MBA were introduced under Satellite Programme of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in 2010 and 2012 respectively. Sr. Rubha succeeded Dr. Sr. Mary Gilda as Principal incharge from 2010-2011. Dr. Sr. Rosalie Joseph assumed charge as Principal in 2011. B.A English was introduced in 2013. Two new courses in Commerce - B.Com & M.Com was started in the academic year 2014-2015. Dr.Sr.Mary Gilda assumed charge as Principal and Secretary of our college from 2015. M.A English was introduced in the year 2016-2017. Research Centre for Commerce was established in March 2020. B.Sc., Psychology was introduced in the year 2022-2023. Dr.Sr.M.S. Rubha was appointed as Secretary and Principal from this academic year.

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GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

The good name of the College is in the hands of the students whether on or off the premises. The College has utmost faith in its students and in their desire to uphold its standard.

The academic year is divided into two semesters. If a student leaves the College during a semester she has no right to claim remission of fees.

The fee should be paid by the students within ten working days from the commencement of the academic year.

Students are expected to assemble in the class room soon after the first bell.

- 1. A gate pass from the Principal / HOD is required to leave the premises during college hours.
- 2. If any student is ill, she must go to the non-residential centre with the permission of the HOD and the Principal.
- 3. Students must respectfully wish a member of the college staff when they meet her.
- 4. They must be courteous in and outside the college in speech and action.
- 5. Students who lose anything or find anything that does not belong to them should report it to the college office.
- Students should consider college property as their own and should cause no wilful damage.
- 7. Disobedience, irregular attendance, malpractices in examinations, habitual carelessness, bad conduct and manners, and non observance of the rules of the college shall meet with strong disciplinary action which may entail dismissal from college.
- 8. Regularity and punctuality for classes and tests are important. Absentees from Internal tests and Model exams due to illness or authorized participation in college or University programme will be considered for retest. Absence due to illness must be supported by a valid medical certificate.

- 9. Students should be neat and decent in their dress and person.
- 10. Any change of address should be intimated to the college by the students/parents
- 11. Electronic gadgets like Camera, Cellphone, I Pad, Pager, Transistor, Walkman etc., should not be brought to the college.
- 12. Students should not collect money without the prior permission from the Principal.

ATTENDANCE

Every student shall attend the class regularly. If any student is absent even for one period of any half day, she shall be considered as absent for the entire half day.

A candidate must have 75% of attendence per semester to appear for the semaster examination. Candidates who have less than 75% of attendance but above 65% will have to remit condonation fee to the university to appear for the semester exam.

A student shall not be absent from a class except for valid reasons. She should apply for leave in advance to the Principal in the prescribed leave form, which could be obtained from the college office.

The application form should be countersigned by the parent / guardian and the respective class teacher and Head of the Department.

Leave letter should be produced on the day when the student returns to the college.

TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

Class Tests, Internal Tests, Model Exams and Semester Exams are obligatory for all students. The marks of the internal tests and semester exams are reported by concerned department to the parents. Before the end of every month..... the parents. This is to rouse the responsibility of the parents and to get their co



operation in the common cause of education. Students are responsible for their university examination hall tickets. No duplicate will be issued.

LIBRARY

- 1. It is obligatory for all students of the college to be members of the library and reading room.
- 2. The Library will be opened from 8.30 a.m. to 4.p.m. on all working days, except on Saturdays.
- 3. Every student shall have an identity card for library usage.
- 4. Students will be given one library token for UGs and two tokens for PGs. When a book is borrowed a token is to be given at the counter. The token will be returned to the borrower when the book is returned. Not more than two books will be issued at a time.
- 5. The library tokens are not transferrable.
- 6. Special care should be taken to see that the library tokens are not misplaced or lost. All losses are to be reported immediately to the Librarian. Duplicate tokens will be issued after a fortnight on payment of Re.1/- for each token.
- 7. Strict silence must be maintained in the library and its premises.
- 8. Students have the privilege of direct access to the shelves in the stock room and the reading room. They are requested to respect the freedom and not to violate it.
- 9. A student can keep a book for not more than 10 days. When the prescribed time has elapsed the book must be returned to the Librarian by the student herself.
- 10. Absence from the college shall not be an excuse for any delay in returning the books. Books due on a holiday shall be returned on the next working day and no fine will be levied on that.

- 11. The books may be returned on all working days.
- 12. A student failing to return a book within the prescribed time shall pay an over due charge of 50 paise per book per day and she will not be allowed the use of the library till the due is paid.
- 13. At the end of each semester all books must be returned before the closing date.
- 14. Reference books shall not be lent out.
- 15. No one is allowed to pass on any book to any one or to lend them to anyone in or out of the college.
- 16. No one is allowed to bring any other book or article inside the library.
- 17. Borrowers on receiving books are expected to examine them before they leave the library and report to the Librarian, any damage, if noticed.
- 18. The Librarian will examine all books returned and if any book has been damaged, she will at once report it to the Principal together with the name of the person responsible. If a book is damaged, lost or spoiled, the person responsible shall supply the library with a new copy.
- 19. Books should be handled with love and care. Marking on books is most objectionable. Students are strictly forbidden to tear, damage or scribble on pages of magazines, periodicals and books. Any student found doing so will be punished severely.

HOSTEL

- 1. A student not residing with parents or relatives is expected to live in the college hostel. Hostel students shall be under the care of the Principal and Warden and they must abide by the hostel rules.
- 2. Day Scholars should not visit the hostel.
